The March 2010 Level 1 CAIA® Curriculum

The March 2010 Level 1 CAIA® curriculum is updated to reflect all industry changes and errata found in the previous exam window curriculum. The curriculum has undergone approximately 10% turnover for the March 2010 exam. The changes include:

- The Quantitative Methods section from September 2009 was deleted from the curriculum.
- The three Real Estate readings from September 2009 were replaced with four new readings covering REITs, real estate indices, and real estate investment considerations and styles.
- Five new readings covering alternative asset classification, beta and alpha drivers, hedge fund benchmarks, asset allocation, incentive fees, and new developments in CDOs were added to the curriculum.
