The March 2010 Level 2 CAIA® Curriculum

The Level 2 March 2010 CAIA® curriculum is updated to reflect all industry changes and errata found in the previous exam window curriculum. The curriculum has undergone approximately 55% turnover for the March 2010 exam. The changes include:

- The Quantitative Trading Strategies section from September 2009 was deleted from the curriculum.
- Thirteen new readings covering commodities and managed futures were added to the curriculum.
- The REIT material from September 2009 was replaced with 11 new readings covering various aspects of real estate investments.
- A new Hedge Fund section with nine new readings was added to the curriculum.
- Two new readings covering risk management and credit derivatives were added to the Current and Integrated Topics section of the curriculum.
