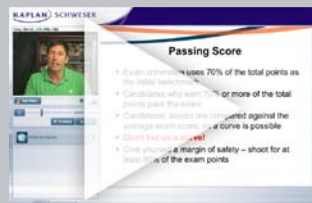
The September 2010 Level 2 CAIA® Curriculum

The Level 2 September 2010 CAIA® curriculum has been updated to reflect all industry changes and errata found in the previous exam window curriculum. The curriculum has undergone approximately 12% turnover for the September 2010 exam. The changes include the following:

- Two new readings covering the economics of structure finance and financial regulation were added to the Structured Products, New Products and Strategies, and Regulation topic.
- Two new readings covering the liquidity risk, horizon uncertainty, and beta overlay strategies were added to the Portfolio and Risk Management topic.
- Four new readings covering private equity investment management, REIT momentum, real estate mutual fund performance, and hedge fund manager risk taking behavior were added to the Research Issues in Alternative Investments topic.
- Four new Learning Objectives were added to the IRR reading in the Private Equity topic.
