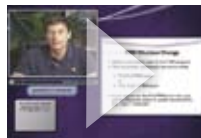

GARP® Introduces New Expanded FRM® Program with Two-Part Exam Format

Starting in the May 2010 exam window, the FRM® Exam transitioned into a two-part format. Both Part 1 and Part 2 will be available semi-annually, in May and November. Both exams will be offered on the same day and at the same exam site. Candidates who choose to sit for both exams on the same day must pass Part 1 before their Part 2 exam is graded. Candidates who fail Part 1 must re-register for Part 1 and Part 2 because their Part 2 exam will not have been graded. 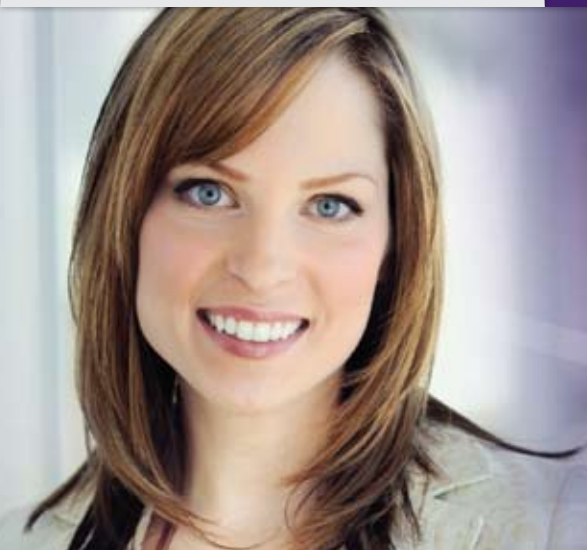

Foundations of Risk Management	20%
Quantitative Analysis	20%
Financial Markets and Products	30%
Valuation and Risk Models	30%

The November 2010 FRM Exam Part 2, consisting of 80 multiple-choice questions, tests a candidate's knowledge base in five main topic areas. Below are the topics by weight:

TOPICS COVERED	WEIGHT
Market Risk Measurement and Management	25%
Credit Risk Measurement and Management	25%
Operational and Integrated Risk Management	25%
Risk Management and Investment Management	15%
Current Issues in Financial Markets	10%
