### What's New at The American College?

On October 1, 2009, The American College added a seventh required course (332: Financial Planning Applications) to the ChFC® curriculum. If you started your ChFC before that date you are not required to take the new course. If you started your ChFC on October 1, 2009 or after, you are required to take it.

In January of 2010, the American College added a fourth elective course (342: Executive Compensation) to the ChFC curriculum. (You are still required to take two elective courses to complete your ChFC.)

### What's New at the American Institute for CPCU®?

The CPCU® experience requirement has been changed from 3 years to 2 years. The requirement is applicable to all CPCU students and candidates who will be conferred in 2010 and beyond.

Starting in 2010, the exams for these three courses have changed from short essay to an objective format, similar to the CPCU 553 and CPCU 557 exams (85 to 100 questions in a three-hour exam).

- CPCU 520—Insurance Operations, Regulation, and Statutory Accounting
- CPCU 530—The Legal Environment of Insurance
- CPCU 540—Finance for Risk Management and Insurance Professionals
